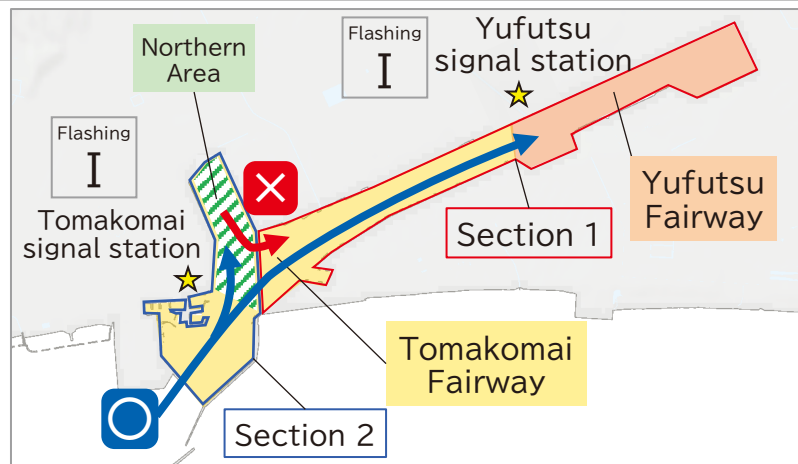


Tomakomai Port Signal

Vessels of **500 GT or more**

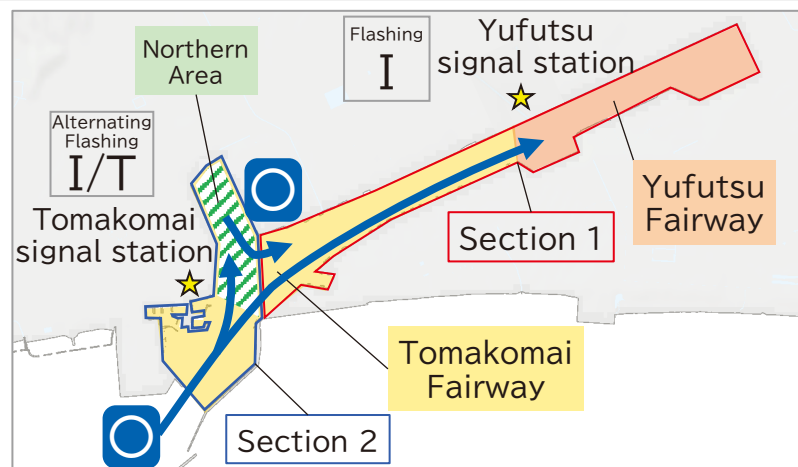
Flashing I

- Inward-bound vessels may proceed to the fairway.
- Outward-bound vessels shall stop.
- Vessels are not permitted to move from Northern Area to Section 1.



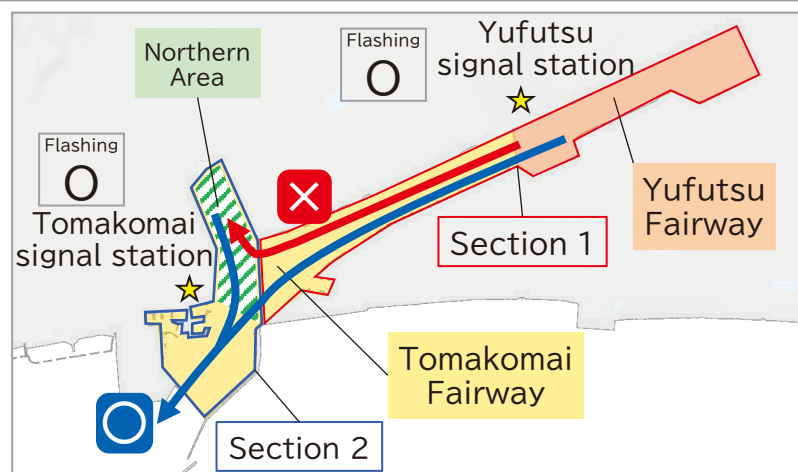
Alternating Flashing I/T

- Inward-bound vessels may proceed to the fairway.
- Outward-bound vessels shall stop.
- Vessels are permitted to move from Northern Area to Section 1.



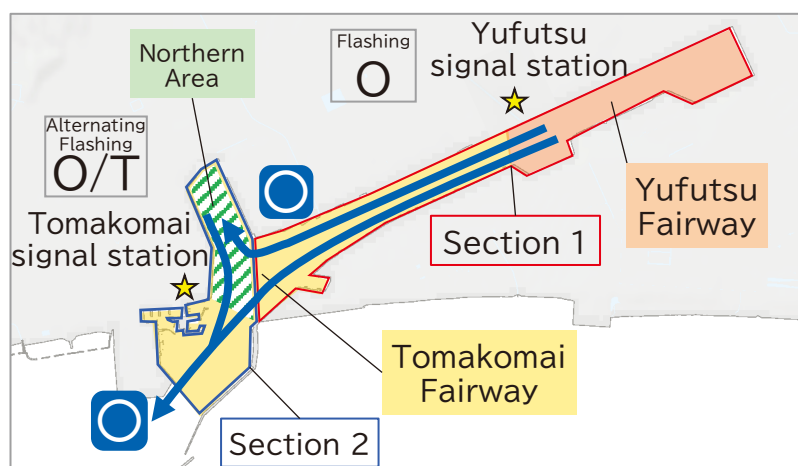
Flashing O

- Outward-bound vessels may take departure through the fairway.
- Inward-bound vessels shall stop.
- Vessels are not permitted to move from Section 1 to Northern Area.



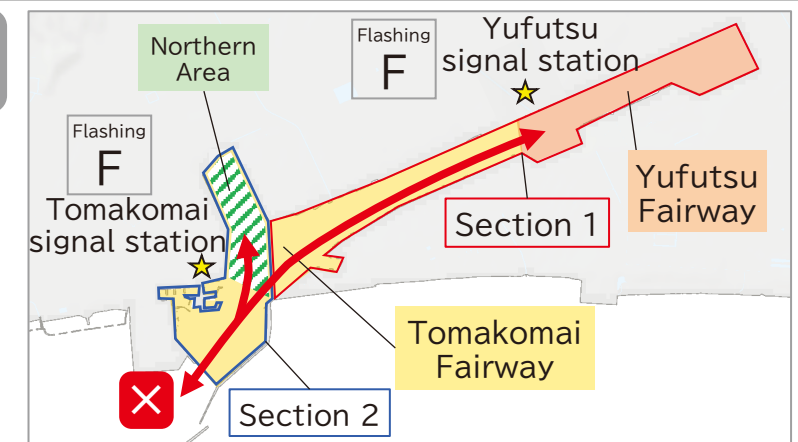
Alternating Flashing O/T

- Outward-bound vessels may take departure through the fairway.
- Inward-bound vessels shall stop.
- Vessels are permitted to move from Section 1 to Northern Area.



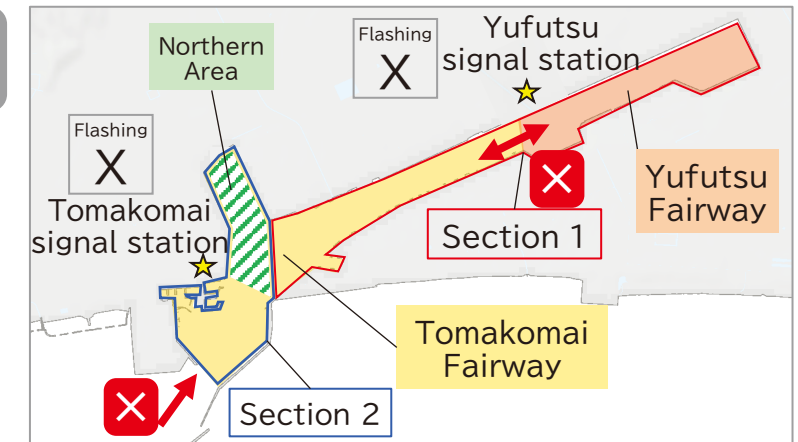
Flashing F

- Inward-bound vessels shall stand by off the fairway.
- Outward-bound vessels shall stop.



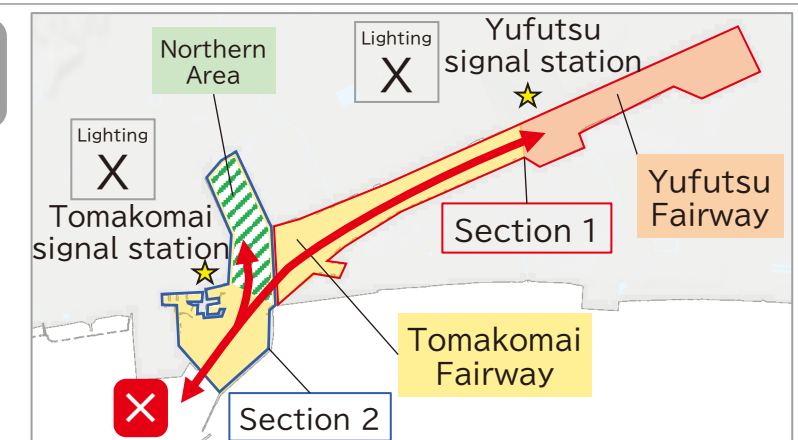
Flashing X

- The signal will soon turn into lighting X.
- No entry to fairway.
- Moored vessels may not depart.
- Vessels navigating in the fairway are permitted to navigate.



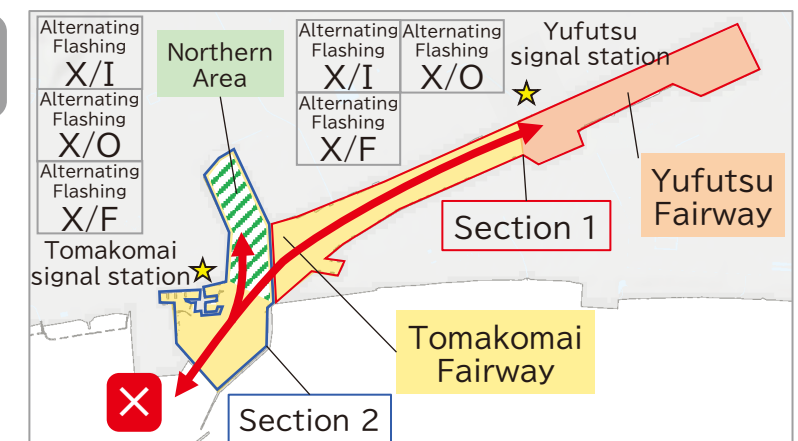
Lighting X

- All traffic prohibited except the vessels instructed by Captain of the Port.



Alternating Flashing X/I X/O X/F

- These signals make a preliminary notice of change letter from X to I, O or F.
- Inward-bound and outward-bound vessels outside the fairway may not proceed to the fairway.
- Moored vessels may not depart.

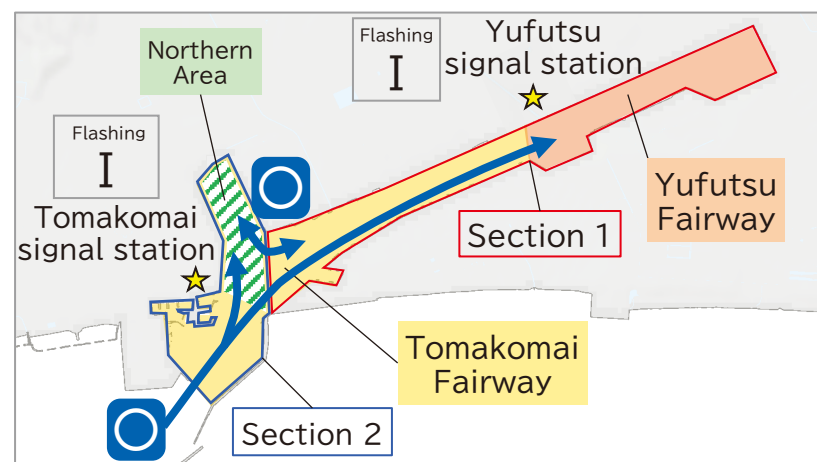

vessels of **less than 500 GT**

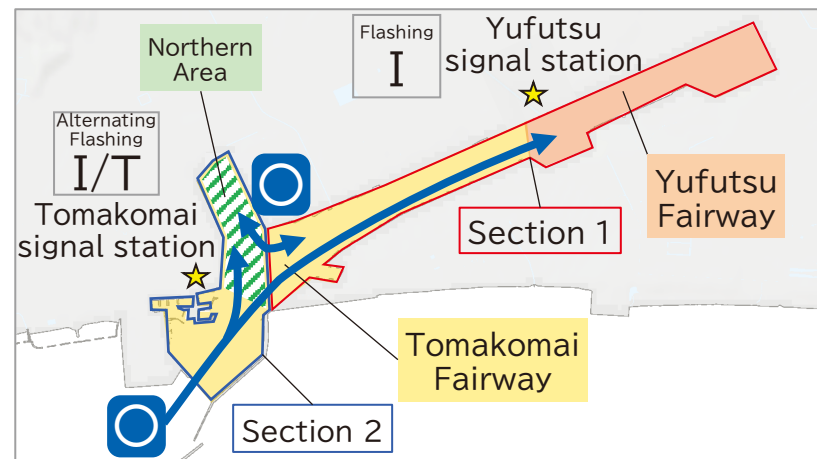
Flashing I

- Inward-bound vessels may proceed to the fairway.
- Outward-bound vessels may take departure through the fairway.



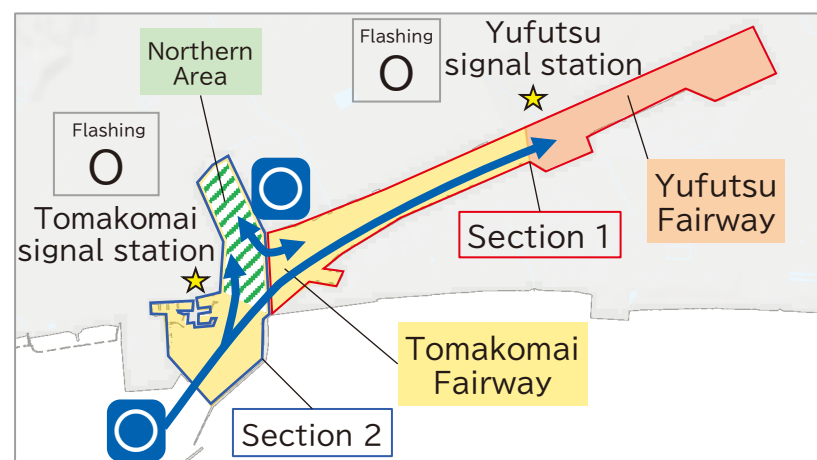
Alternating Flashing I/T

- Outward-bound vessels may take departure through the fairway.



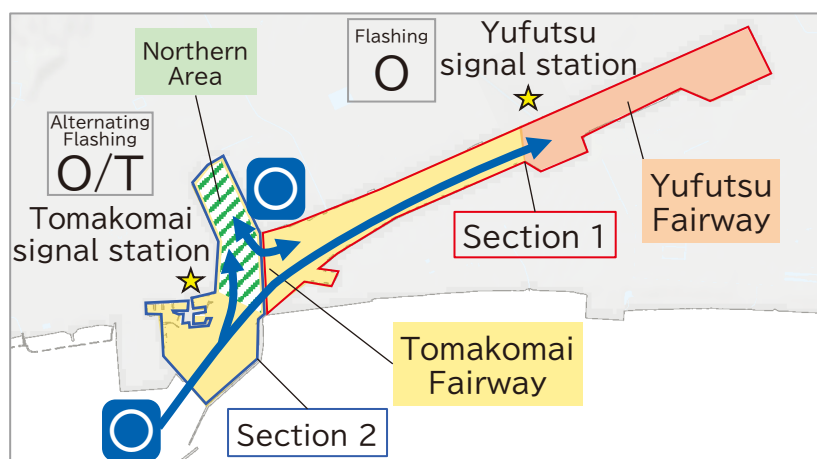
Flashing O

- Inward-bound vessels may proceed to the fairway.



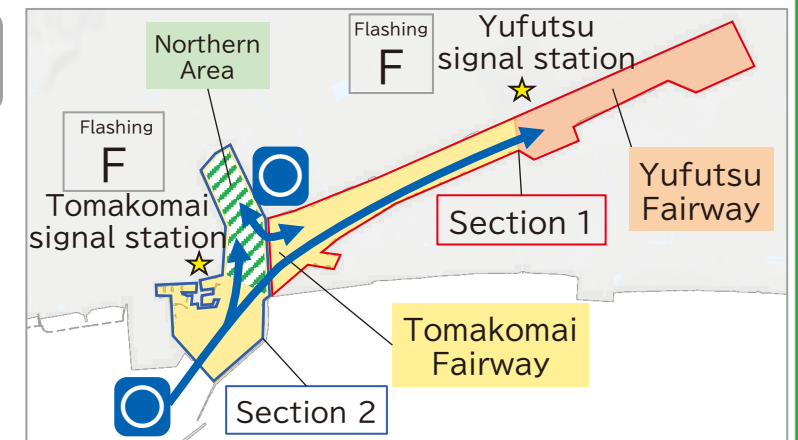
Alternating Flashing O/T

- Inward-bound vessels may proceed to the fairway.



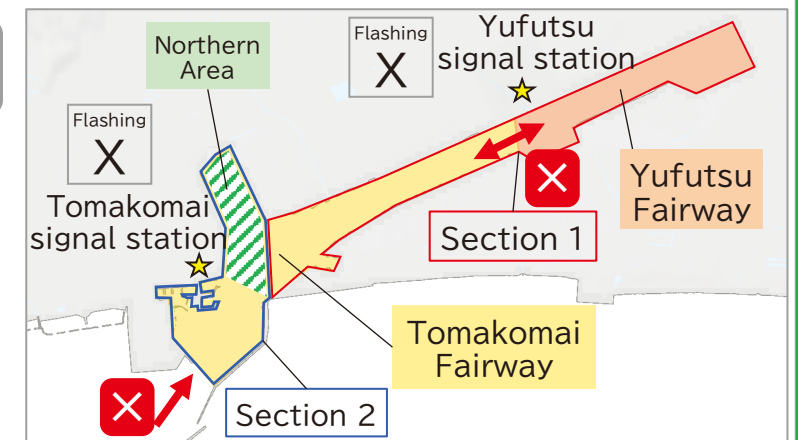
Flashing F

- Outward-bound vessels may take departure through the fairway.



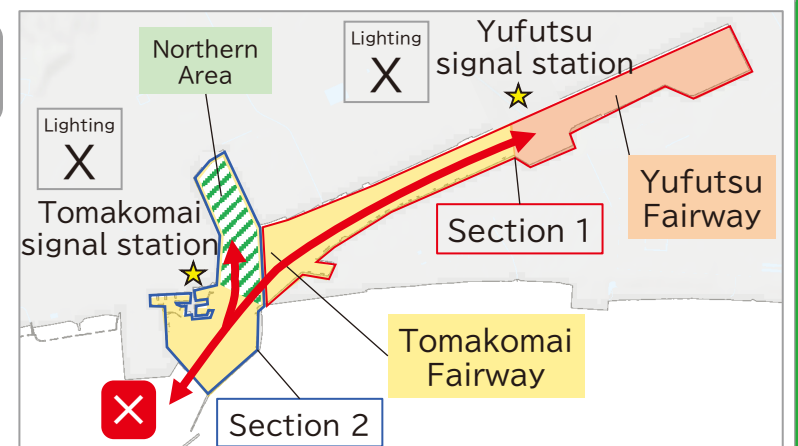
Flashing X

- The signal will soon turn into lighting X.

- Moored vessels may not depart. Vessels navigating in the fairway are permitted to navigate.



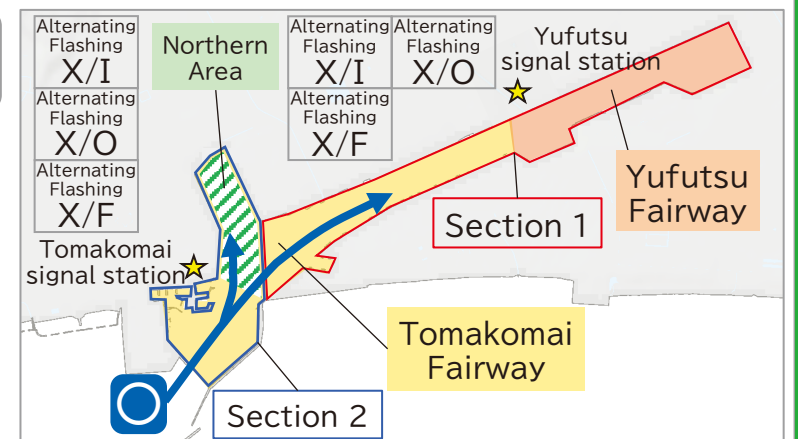
Lighting X

- All traffic prohibited except the vessels instructed by Captain of the Port.



Alternating Flashing X/I X/O X/F

- These signals make a preliminary notice of change letter from X to I, O or F.
- Inward-bound and outward-bound vessels outside the fairway may proceed to the fairway.
- Moored vessels may not depart.
