When 4th Coast Guard regional Headquarters Commander issues a [RECOMMENDATION] or [NOTICE] for evacuation because of typhoon, Designated vessels should evacuate from Ise Bay and Mikawa Bay to a safe area (outside) with little influence from the typhoon.

When recommendation and notice are issued, we will notify you by Maritime Information and Communication System.
